

YOUR CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS


THESE RIGHTS APPLY BEFORE ANY OTHER LAWS

YOU HAVE RIGHTS AS A DETAINEE

You have the right to say nothing about what happened and to be presumed innocent. You have the right to know why you are being detained and of what you are being accused. You have a right to a fair trial within a reasonable time. You also have the right to challenge the fact you have been detained.

YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO HUMAN DIGNITY

Everyone has the right to human dignity. If you are detained, this means the state must give you enough food and medical care. You have the right to consult with a lawyer and the right to be visited by your family and doctor. No one is allowed to torture you ever.
